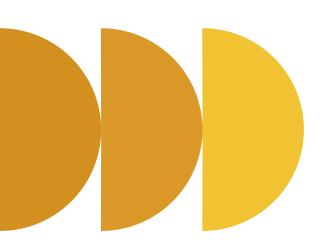






### Introduction

## The Real Cost of a Call-Out

Revenue impact

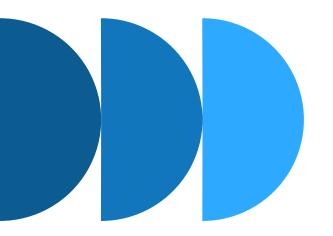
A single missed DVM shift can cost \$3,000–\$5,000 in lost billables.

Team impact

68% of staff report higher stress when covering for last-minute absences.

**Client impact** 

Missed appointments create backlog, increasing client churn risk by 17%.







## Case Study Example



#### Dr. Lee's small animal hospital in Texas lost one tech for a week due to illness:

- Doctors ran 20 minutes behind all day.
- Reception handled triage, leading to medical errors.
- 14 clients canceled future visits.
- That one absence equaled \$24,000 in lost revenue.





## Why Veterinary Clinics Struggle More Than Others

- 7 Thin staffing margins compared to human healthcare.
- Emotional labor is higher client anger compounds stress.
- Replacement timelines average 8–12 weeks for a DVM hire.





## Strategies to Avoid the Scramble

- Build float pools of technicians and assistants.
- Use staggered scheduling to avoid bottlenecks.
- Partner with staffing agencies that can provide same-week coverage from pre-vetted candidates.



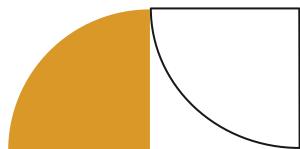
